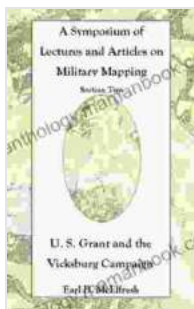


Grant and the Vicksburg Campaign: Symposium of Lectures and Articles on Military History

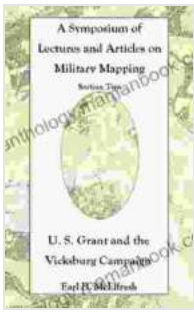
