Repeat rows 6-15 seven times, or until the scarf reaches the desired length.

Bind off: K all stitches, then cut the yarn and pull it through the last stitch on the left-hand needle.

Finishing: Weave in any loose ends and block the scarf to give it a neat and professional finish.
